1ST QUARTER 2015

- Total population was 640,700, an increase of 4,500 quarter-to-quarter; female population accounted for 50.6% of the total.
- There were 1,711 live births delivered, a decrease of 375 quarter-to-quarter. The sex ratio at birth stood at 111.5. Mortality totalled 536, an increase of 49 quarter-to-quarter.
- In the first quarter of 2015, there were 2,639 Chinese immigrants, up by 995 quarter-to-quarter. Individuals granted right of abode totalled 600, a slight increase of 3.
- Non-resident workers totalled 174,924 at the end of the first quarter, up by 4,578 quarter-to-quarter.


