

- The population of Macao (also referred to as the total population) was 687,900 at the end of the first quarter of 2025, down by 400 quarter-on-quarter. The female population was 369,600, accounting for 53.7% of the total.
- Number of live births went down by 237 quarter-on-quarter to 750, while mortality grew by 26 to 637.
- In the first quarter, new arrivals from mainland China with one-way permit decreased by 547 quarter-on-quarter to 685, whereas the number of individuals newly granted right of abode went up by 253 to 539.
- Non-resident workers totalled 183,368 at the end of the first quarter, up by 826 quarter-on-quarter.

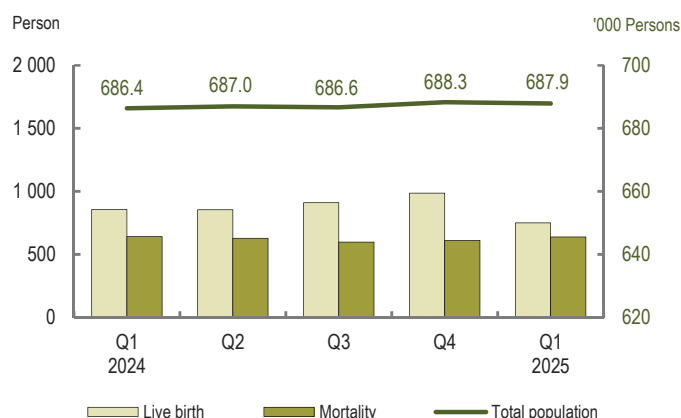

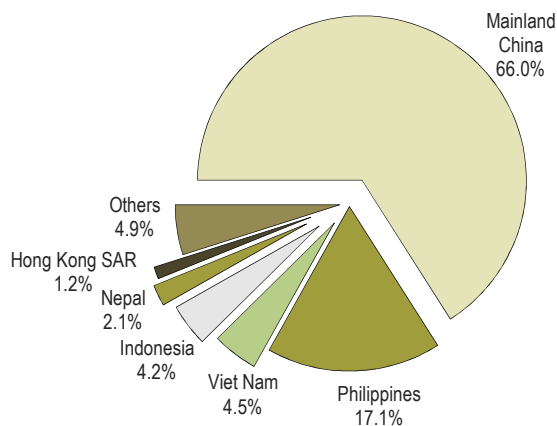
