

# Employment Survey

May - July / 2010

Total labour force was 326 000 in May-July 2010, with 317 000 being employed and 9 600 being unemployed. Among the unemployed, 11.2% were fresh labour force entrants searching for their first job.

Labour force participation rate was 71.5%, down by 0.1 and 1.3 percentage points respectively over the previous period (April-June 2010) and the corresponding period of 2009.

The unemployment rate was 2.9%, up by 0.1 percentage point over the previous period, but down by 0.8 percentage point year-on-year.

The underemployment rate was 1.8%, a decrease of 0.1 percentage point when compared with the previous period and the same period of 2009.

### Concepts:

**Labour force:** Individuals aged 16 or over who are available to participate in the production of goods and/or services during the reference period. It comprises the employed population and unemployed population.

**Labour force participation rate:** The proportion of the economically active population to the Macao population aged 16 or over.

**Unemployment rate:** Percentage share of the number of the unemployed to the total labour force.

**Underemployment rate:** Percentage share of the number of the underemployed to the total labour force.

### Coverage:

The survey covers all land-based population living in domestic living quarters in the Macao Peninsula and the islands of Taipa and Coloane, excluding those in collective living quarters such as military camp, hospital, prison, dormitory and elderly home.
