

POPULATION ESTIMATE

2016

Government of Macao Special Administrative Region Statistics and Census Service

- Population estimate of Macao was 644,900 at end-2016, down by 1,900 or 0.3% year-on-year. Males accounted for 47.4% and females constituted 52.6%.
- For the whole year of 2016, live births and mortality increased by 1.3% and 12.3% respectively year-on-year; rate of natural increase was 7.5%.
- A net migration of -6,800 was recorded, attributable to a decrease in the number of non-resident workers living in Macao.
- Population of the Coloane Island increased to 26,700, with its proportion rising by 0.7 percentage points to 4.1%.





Glossary

Natural increase: Number of live births minus number of deaths for the year.

Rate of natural increase: Natural increase per 1,000 persons at mid-year.

Net migration: Net balance of population movements, including Chineses immigrants, individuals granted right of abode, non-resident workers and foreign students living in Macao, etc.

Dependency ratio: The percentage share of population aged 0-14 and 65 and above to the population aged 15-64.

Youth dependency ratio: The percentage share of population aged 0-14 to the population aged 15-64.

Elderly dependency ratio: The percentage share of population aged 65 and above to the population aged 15-64.

Ageing ratio: The percentage share of population aged 65 and above to the population aged 0-14.

Birth rate: Number of live births per 1,000 persons at mid-year.

Mortality rate: Number of deaths per 1,000 persons at mid-year.

Totals may not correspond to the sum of separate figures due to rounding.
