



Government of Macao Special Administrative Region Statistics and Census Service 2017

- Population estimate of Macao was 653,100 at end-2017, up by 8,200 or 1.3% year-on-year. Males and females accounted for 47.0% and 53.0% of the total population respectively.
- For the whole year of 2017, live births and mortality decreased by 8.6% and 5.7% respectively year-on-year; the rate of natural increase was 6.8%.
- Migration flow reversed from a net outflow in 2016 to a net inflow of 3,800 in 2017.
- The population in the Parish of Nossa Senhora de Fátima, the most populous area, increased by 1.1% year-on-year to 246,600, taking up 37.8% of the total population.



Glossary

Natural increase: Number of live births minus number of deaths for the year.

Rate of natural increase: Natural increase per 1,000 persons at mid-year.

Net migration: Net balance of population movements, including Chinese immigrants, individuals granted right of abode, non-resident workers and foreign students living in Macao, etc.

Dependency ratio: The percentage share of population aged 0-14 and 65 and above to the population aged 15-64.

Youth dependency ratio: The percentage share of population aged 0-14 to the population aged 15-64.

Elderly dependency ratio: The percentage share of population aged 65 and above to the population aged 15-64.

Ageing ratio: The percentage share of population aged 65 and above to the population aged 0-14.

Birth rate: Number of live births per 1,000 persons at mid-year.

Mortality rate: Number of deaths per 1,000 persons at mid-year.
