

- Total population was 614,500, an increase of 7,000 quarter-to-quarter; female population totalled 314,600, accounting for 51.2% of the total.
- There were 1,637 live births delivered, a decrease of 119 quarter-to-quarter. The gender ratio of the newborn stood at 104.4. Mortality cases totalled 543, an increase of 15 quarter-to-quarter.
- Chinese immigrants totalled 800 and the individuals granted right of abode registered a net inflow of 158, a decrease of 147 and 297 respectively quarter-to-quarter.
- Non-resident workers totalled 145,692 at the end of the first quarter, an increase of 7,854 quarter-to-quarter.




