

Statistics and Census Service

- Total population was 649,100, an increase of 2,300 quarter-to-quarter; female population accounted for 51.0% of the total.
- There were 1,664 live births delivered, a decrease of 198 quarter-to-quarter. The sex ratio at birth stood at 109.6. Mortality totalled 650, an increase of 165 quarter-to-quarter.
- Chinese immigrants totalled 2,695, up by 514 quarter-to-quarter. Individuals granted right of abode totalled 339, a decrease of 55.
- Non-resident workers totalled 181,436 at the end of the first quarter, down by 210 quarter-to-quarter.




