- Total population was 647,700, a decrease of 4,800 quarter-to-quarter; female population accounted for 51.4% of the total.
- There were 1,885 live births delivered, up by 246 quarter-to-quarter. The sex ratio at birth stood at 113.7. Mortality totalled 480, down by 85 quarter-to-quarter. In the first three quarters of 2016, live births decreased slightly by 0.1% year-on-year, while mortality increased by 12.3%.
- Chinese immigrants totalled 1,573, up by 302 quarter-to-quarter. Individuals granted right of abode totalled 373, up by 34.
- Non-resident workers totalled 180,277 at the end of the third quarter, down by 2,182 quarter-to-guarter.


