

- Total population was 648,500, a slight increase of 100 quarter-to-quarter; female population accounted for 53.0% of the total.
- There were 1,690 live births delivered, an increase of 94 quarter-to-quarter. The sex ratio at birth stood at 113.9. Mortality totalled 529, up by 7 quarter-to-quarter. In the first three quarters of 2017, live births (4,846) and mortality (1,558) decreased by 6.6% and 8.9% respectively year-on-year.
- Chinese immigrants totalled 1,274, up by 498 quarter-to-quarter; individuals granted right of abode totalled 387, up by 5.
- Non-resident workers totalled 176,666 at the end of the third quarter of 2017, down by 2,028 quarter-to-quarter.

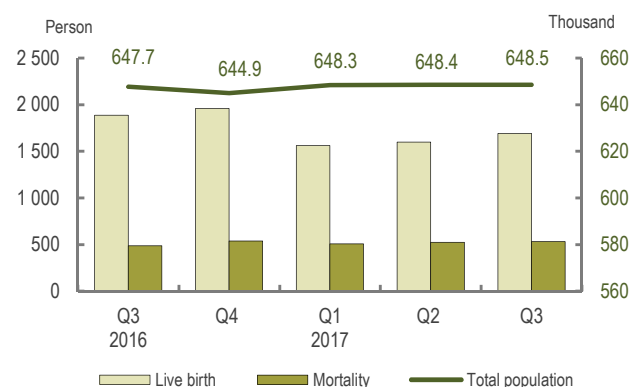

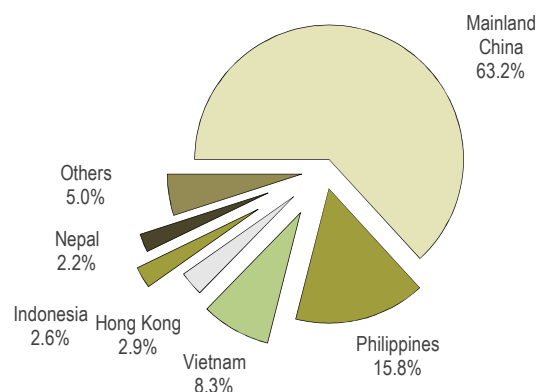
